

Invitation to the 3d Community of Practice workshop on EBA in MSP

Overview of good EBA practices in MSP and how it can be utilized to analyse gaps in international EBA framework.

What:

The eMSP project has a learning strand on EBA in MSP which invites the EBA community of practice and project partners to joint an online workshop.

When:

The workshop will be held 2 December 2022 10-13 EET/9-12 CET (timeframe may be adjusted according to feedback from participants)

Intention and objective:

-To deepen a joint understanding of EBA in MSP based on current best practices.

-To discuss a gap-analysis approach as the next step

The learning strand on EBA terms of reference identifies the main objective of the learning strand is to enhance the ecosystem-based approach in MSP through, among all, strengthening of international framework for EBA in MSP. An overview of good practices of EBA in MSP and respective challenges will to lay the basis for a gap analysis and development proposals for further advancement of international EBA in MSP framework. In addition, the learning strand involves two study cases, which are intended to complement theoretical investigation, illustrating good EBA practices compiled from North Sea and Baltic Sea regions. **An overview of good EBA practices in MSP will be presented and the workshop will be invited to discuss how it can be utilized to analyse gaps in international EBA framework and address them.** Current state of study case will be presented and their use to illustrate EBA application discussed.
